Post-Secondary Scholarship Application Instructions 2017

Scholarship Review Committee:

Applications for the LIUNA, Local 837 post-secondary scholarships are judged by a Review Committee composed of individuals chosen by the Executive Committee of Local 837. There are no members of Local 837 or LIUNA on the Review Committee and all decisions on scholarships are made by the Review Committee and are final. All material and information on the applications that may identify the applicant are removed before they are judged by the Review Committee. Applications are judged on the basis of three criteria: the academic record of the student; the essay, and citizenship. Each of these areas is given equal consideration by the Review Committee.

Application Information:

This application has three parts. **First**, an official transcript of the student's high school, college or university record must be submitted by the student. **Second**, applicants who are entering their first year of post-secondary studies must include a copy of their letter of acceptance from the college or university they will be attending. **Third**, applicants must complete the Citizenship and Essay portions of this application.

Instructions:

This application form contains two sections. Applicants are asked to type out each section and attach to this form:

Section A:

CITIZENSHIP:

Please identify the activities that you are involved in both inside and outside of your school, in addition to your mandatory high school requirement. For each activity, outline how it contributes to your community, to your well-being and the well-being of your family.

Section B:

ESSAY:

Applicants are asked to type a 500 word essay on the following topic (longer essays will not be read by the Review Committee**).**

Topic:

Define how you understand the term “inclusion” and explain how you could foster greater inclusion in your community.

IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT YOU MARK ALL PAGES OF YOUR WORK WITH YOUR NAME. KEEP IN MIND, HOWEVER, THAT YOUR NAME WILL BE REMOVED BEFORE THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE REVIEWS YOUR WORK.
